Subject: Ravel Car Park, Antonio Vivaldistraat

Dear Sir or Madam,

We would hereby like to you inform you of the work that is going to be carried out on the new Ravel car park on **Antonio Vivaldistraat**, opposite the EY Cross Towers, **from Monday 9 January 2017**. This letter contains information on the work, how it will affect you, and how we plan to keep you informed of the progress.

Ravel Car Park

On Monday 9 January, the construction of the building site will commence. On Monday 16 January, we will start installing the foundation piles. This will take approximately 9 weeks. The foundation piles will be bolted to keep noise nuisance and vibration to a minimum. As a result, the installation will take longer than usual. Once the foundation piles have been installed, temporary sheet piling will be installed over a period of 3 weeks, to allow for the construction pit to be excavated over a period of 4 weeks. As the piling sheets are relatively short, they are going to be drilled into the ground. This may cause noise nuisance.

Planning and Construction site

The car park is being built opposite the Cross Towers office building. The work is scheduled to start on Monday 9 January 2017. It is expected to be completed at the end of December 2017.

The entrance to the building site is near Beethovenstraat/the A10 underpass, so the Vivaldistraat and Strozilaan area will not be affected by construction traffic. For the time being, cars can still leave the area via the usual route after 16:00.
